

The process of scar healing:

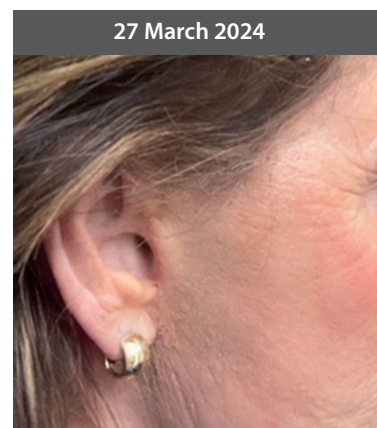
A personal account of scar healing following a face and neck lift

Case description

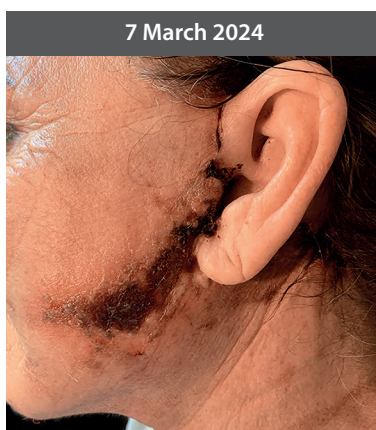
Gender	Female
Cause	A wound following a face and neck lift on 29 February
Recovery following a face and neck lift	- The right side healed nicely. The wound was fully closed by the end of March. - One week after the procedure, the suture on the left side came undone and a wound formed. A highly contracting scab formed on top of the wound, which caused the patient a lot of discomfort. She also experienced ongoing itchiness. To alleviate the symptoms, the scab was removed on 19 March. This provided great relief.
Why scar treatment	The scar on the left side was red and itchy.
Start of scar treatment	16 April 2024
Therapy	Silicone gel twice a day. From 17 May 2024, Bapscarcare SPF Gel due to wish to protect the scar from UV rays.

Right side: healing following surgery, resulting in a normal scar

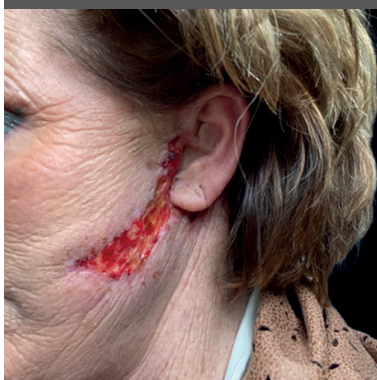


Left side: before removing the scab

Left side: start silicone therapy (after wound has closed)

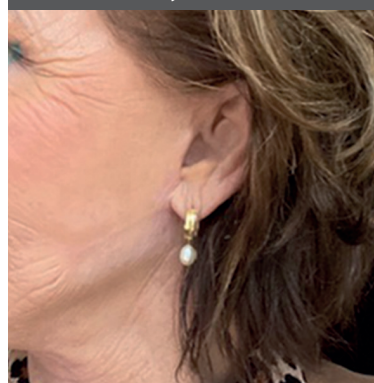
22 April 2024
